There are several activities coming up over the next few months, so please check your diaries and get involved as much as you are able - including the Thursday night net. This year Acorns is going to grow.

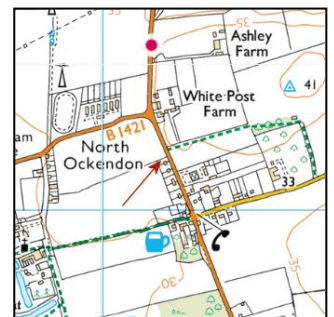

### Saturday 16th March: 1pm-5pm. Club 2m Activity Afternoon

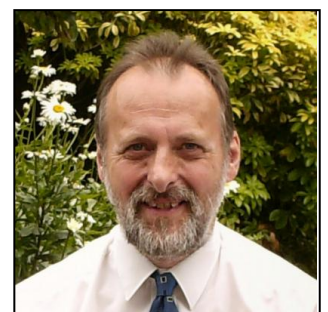
